#### # Apiary Report

Our apiary officer, Phillip Chatfield has filed the following report on 30.7.2016 for hives 1 to 9. The top Super checked, in all cases the bees were in the top box and doing well. Returning bees are bringing back two types of pollen. Supers removed from hive number 7 and put in extraction room for Sunday 31.7.2016. Hives could be left as is, (ie.do not reduce height).

## # Honey Extraction Kits

We now have 4 good honey extraction kits available for members. These kits include, a 3 frame honey extractor, heated knife, uncapping fork plus wax cap bag to spin excess honey from your wax. There is a bond plus a nominal fee of \$20 to cover repairs and maintenance of the equipment. For more information please see Ivan in the bee keepers shop.
